

# Bank theft details surface

Police say Williams, Fatka forged forms

### STEAMBOAT SPRINGS

The \$1.2 million reported stolen from accounts at the Steamboat Springs branch of Alpine Bank is suspected to have come from forged "advice of charge" forms,

according to police arrest warrants.

Williams and Terri Dawn Fatka were arrested Feb. 21 on suspicion of stealing the money when they worked as bank tellers at Alpine Bank. Each woman has been charged with felony theft and forgery.

The investigation is ongoing with at least five Alpine Bank account holders identified as victims, Steamboat Springs police Detective Jerry Stabile said.

Police believe the thefts took place between April 2005 and Jan. 3, 2008, according to the arrest warrants that are part of Williams' and Fatka's case files at the Routt County
