**Cunningham hired**

New superintendent to make \$150,000 a year plus benefits in two-year contract

Dr. Shalee Cunningham, an educational consultant from Napa, Calif., is the new superintendent of the Steamboat Springs School District.

\$150,000 a year-plus benefits in a two-year contract approved unanimously by the Steamboat Springs School Board on Monday night in Centennial Hall. The contract

begins July 1 and ends June 30, 2010, with a renewal option for a third year.

"I am very excited about this new assignment in Steamboat Springs and will be there next week to visit with community, staff, students and school board," Cunningham wrote in a Monday e-mail from Idaho, where she

was visiting family and unavailable for further comment.

Anne Muhme, the district's assistant to the superintendent, confirmed that Cunningham will visit Steamboat Springs from May 7 to 9 and again in June for an administrative retreat.
