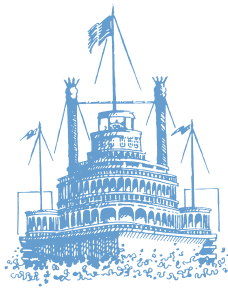

# Smyser: No Knezevich renewal

## School Board to vote Monday on high school principal's contract

### STEAMBOAT SPRINGS

Interim Superintendent Sandra Smyser is recommending that the Steamboat Springs School Board not renew the contract of high school principal

Mike Knezevich, according to documents released Friday.

Contracts for each Steamboat Springs School District principal and assistant principal are up for review every year, but Knezevich's renewal is particularly contentious. More than 50 people attended the

board meeting March 24 when his contract renewal was first discussed, but the board voted to delay action at that time.

The recommendation, credited to Smyser in the agenda packet for Monday's School Board meeting, states, "I believe it is in the best inter-

est of the Steamboat Springs School District to nonrenew the 2008-09 school year contract for Michael Knezevich, however, given the unique timing of this decision, I defer to the Board's discretion."
