### Commissioners limit Sheriff's Office overtime, vehicle use

commissioners County unanimously voted Tuesday to cut back Routt County Sheriff's Office overtime and county vehicle use for the rest of 2008, in what Commissioner Nancy Stahoviak called a ers. "last-ditch effort" to get the department's budget in line.

Effective Nov. 23, overtime may not be paid to any Sheriff's Office employee, except on-call investigators, and the Sheriff's Office is limited to 16,000 miles in its use of county vehicles between today and the end of the year, according to the resolution approved by the commission-
