Local couple dies in crash

Single-engine plane went down Monday 10 miles from Hayden airport

STEAMBOAT SPRINGS

A Steamboat Springs couple died Monday when their singleengine plane crashed about 10 miles west of the runway at Yampa Valley Regional Airport in Hayden.

Joseph and Suzette Brumleve were found dead at the scene,

the Moffat County Sheriff's Office confirmed late Monday night. The cause of the crash won't be determined until the National Transportation Safety Board completes its investigation. An NTSB investigator is expected to arrive in the area today

Routt County Search and Rescue personnel discovered the plane, a 1986 Piper PA- 46 Malibu, at about 4:45 p.m. on farmland about 2 1/2 miles northwest of Elkhead Reservoir. The wreckage was close to Moffat County Road 178.

Moffat County Sheriff's Office Lt. K.C. Hume described the topography of the crash site as rolling agricultural land. There was about 6 inches of snow around the wreckage, he

The fixed-wing, six-passenger plane was inbound from Hutchinson, Kan., where it departed at 9:13 a.m. Mountain Standard Time. According to FlightAware, a Web-based flight tracking service for commercial and private aircraft, the plane was due to arrive at Yampa Valley Regional Airport
