• Newspaper – do not tie or bundle

Household Hazardous Materials

- What are they? · Oil-based paints, varnishes, thinners, strippers, solvents
- Cleaners, gasoline, antifreeze, kerosene,
- Herbicides, pesticides, fertilizers, poisons

• Aerosol cans, mercury, batteries

Hazardous materials usually have labels that say "caution, poisonous, harmful if swallowed, toxic, flammable, corrosive, combustible or dangerous.'

Why are they dangerous?

When poured down the drain, spilled on the ground, or placed in the trash headed for the landfill, these substances may eventually pollute water supplies. These hazardous materials are very harmful to humans and wildlife.

How do I dispose of them?

The Routt County Board of Health has established a residential HHW program. Once per year residents may schedule a low cost (\$20.00) home pickup of household hazardous material up to 12 gallons. Electronic equipment may also be picked up at the same time, for a fee. Call Curbside at 1-800-449-7587 and they will set a date for your HHW pick-up. Businesses may call 1-800-449-7587 to inquire about service to their facility. Please call Routt County Environmental Health with any questions at 879-0185.
